The Threshing Barn

Our refurbished 18th century Threshing Barn is an impressive and versatile space, full of rustic charm.

The barn is a beautiful setting for an indoor ceremony, and with the help of a little River Cottage team magic, can swiftly become a magnificent setting for your wedding breakfast.

Seating up to 70 guests and accommodating 120 standing, your evening party can dance into the small hours as a DJ or band of your choice help you celebrate your big day.





The Kitchen Garden

The Kitchen Garden is at the heart of River Cottage and is where much of the fruit and veg that feeds our guests is grown. The famous



The Farmhouse

The iconic 17th century Farmhouse sits at the centre of the farm and can be used in many ways during your wedding.

For smaller numbers, with a wood burning fire and old wobbly beams, the cosy Farmhouse living space is a wonderful indoor location for your ceremony. After the ceremony, the room transforms into the perfect intimate setting for your wedding breakfast.

For larger weddings, the Farmhouse becomes the hub for your nearest and dearest. The Farmhouse sleeps up to 6 guests and is available the night before or after your big day, allowing you and your loved ones to wake up to spectacular views across the Axe Valley, whilst enjoying the charm and tranquillity of River Cottage.





The Yurt

Our cosy yurt is a unique indoor space where your guests can perch on hay bales and enjoy a tipple between the ceremony and wedding breakfast, or before the evening party begins.

The wood burning stove makes the space warm and inviting, and festoon lighting adds to the charm. In the winter months, mugs of coffee, mulled wine and cider served from the stove-top help keep your guests warm as petit fours are served after your meal.

In the summer, the yurt doors are thrown open and the area provides another shaded space for people to gather and make memories.



The Farm

The farm is made up of 100 acres of countryside, nestled in the Axe Valley Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, on the Devon and Dorset border. Your guests are encouraged to explore the entirety of the farm at their leisure and enjoy the blissful rural surroundings.

As well as fields and woodland, the main hub of buildings and the Kitchen Garden, you'll find our poly tunnels and Market Garden, where our garden team grow much of the organic fruit, veg and herbs we'll serve your guests. Explore a bit further and you'll also find organically reared pigs, chickens and sheep, as well as wild rabbits, birds and deer if you're lucky enough to spot them!



Marquees

If you are planning a larger celebration and anticipating more that 70 guests for your daytime celebrations, a marquee may be the perfect option for your big day.

Our Marquee hardstanding sits at the top of our Meadow Field and looks out over the beautiful Axe Valley.

We can facilitate the hiring of a marquee from our trusted thirdparty suppliers, or alternatively, you're very welcome to recommend your own.





Food and Drink

Food is at the heart of everything that we do. All of our wedding menus feature the finest, seasonal, organic ingredients, which we source from local farms and fishermen, as well as using produce grown and reared here at River Cottage.

No wedding menu is the same. During the planning of your wedding, we will arrange for you to meet with one of our talented chefs, where you will collaborate and design your bespoke wedding menu featuring your favourite dishes! You can also choose from our carefully selected drinks range, including a fantastic selection of organic and biodynamic wines, seasonal cocktails and mocktails and much more.
